

Aroclamation

WHEREAS: the Medic Alert Foundation International is a charitable, non-profit organization whose main purpose is to educate and encourage the public to wear on their person identification of any medical problems that should be known in an emergency, and to encourage doctors and nurses to advise persons of the importance of wearing such identification; and

WHEREAS: it is estimated that millions of Americans have some form of illness, allergy or other medical problem that should be brought to the attention of doctors, nurses, persons rendering first aid and others who attempt to assist injured or unconscious parties; and

WHEREAS: more than 450,000 Americans are today wearing the indestructible Medic Alert bracelets and necklace medallions to indicate some hidden medical problem such as diabetes, epilepsy, heart conditions, the need for certain medicine, or an allergy to particular medicines or serums; and

WHEREAS: the Medic Alert bracelets and necklaces carry a serial number for each member as well as the telephone number of the Foundation's central answering service in Turlock, California, where a medical record is maintained on each member and the information in the records is available to physicians and other authorized personnel 24 hours a day on a collect call basis; and

WHEREAS: the Medic Alert Foundation has been endorsed by a great many international, national, state and county associations, societies, agencies and other civic organizations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 9 through April 16, 1978 to be
