WHEREAS: Maynard Speece helped Minnesotans to better understand the character, role and significance of Minnesota's number one industry--Agriculture; and


WHEREAS: this outstanding Minnesotan is retiring after many years of dedicated service;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, April 21, 1978 to be


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to remember the contributions he has made to the people of Minnesota.
