WHEREAS: many disabled Minnesota citizens are not able to participate as fully active members of their communities due to inaccessibility; and

WHEREAS: a significant effort must be made throughout Minnesota to eliminate barriers to employment, housing, transportation, education, public services and public accommodations; and

WHEREAS: the general public needs to be educated as to accessibility problems which disabled persons must deal with in their daily life activities; and



HANDICAPPED AWARENESS DAYS




