WHEREAS: the 1,200 professional teachers of art in Minnesota have committed themselves to integrating art as a unique and creative part of their students' education and lives; and

WHEREAS: the Art Educators of Minnesota (A.E.M.) are holding a spring conference in Brainerd from April 27 through April 30, 1978 with featured speakers such as Dr. Elliot Eisner from Stanford University, the president of the National Art Education Association; and


WHEREAS: the conference was made possible through the competence, leadership and commitment of Minnesota's own artists, teachers, A.E.M. officials and conference task force workers;



ART EDUCATORS DAYS


in Minnesota.
