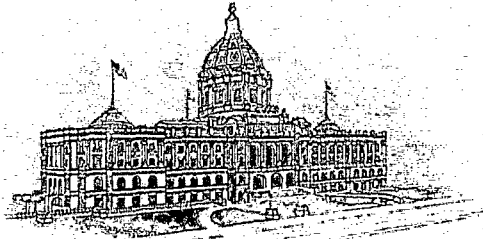

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 12

1 A house concurrent resolution

2 opposing the closing of the Duluth Air Force Base  
3 by the United States Department of Defense.

4

5 WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota already receives far  
6 less than its fair share of national military expenditures;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the Duluth Air Force Base represents  
9 approximately one third of the total existing military  
10 payroll expenditures in the State of Minnesota; and

11 WHEREAS, the Duluth Air Force Base is the only major  
12 Air Force installation in the state, representing 75 percent  
13 of the total Air Force payroll expenditures in the state;  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Defense  
16 recently indicated that the closing of the Duluth Air Force  
17 Base will be announced within the present year; and

18 WHEREAS, this closing will have an economic impact of  
19 thirty-two million dollars upon all of northeastern  
20 Minnesota and further reduce the state's share of national  
21 military expenditures; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the  
2 State of Minnesota, the Senate concurring therein, to oppose  
3 the closing of the Duluth Air Force Base by the United  
4 States Department of Defense; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State be  
6 directed to forward copies of this resolution to the  
7 President of the United States, the Secretary of the  
8 Department of Defense, and the speaker of the house shall  
9 appoint a member of the house and the senate subcommittee on  
10 committees shall appoint a member of the senate to deliver  
11 the resolution to the offices of each Senator and  
12 Representative in the United States Congress from the State  
13 of Minnesota.
