HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 12

A house concurrent resolution 2 opposing the closing of the Duluth Air Force Base by the United States Department of Defense. WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota already receives far less than its fair share of national military expenditures; 7 and WHEREAS, the Dufuth Air Force Base represents 8 approximately one third of the total existing military 10 payroll expenditures in the State of Minnesota; and WHEREAS, the Duluth Air Force Base is the only major 11 Air Force installation in the state, representing 75 percent 12 13 of the total Air Force payroll expenditures in the state; 14 and WHEREAS, the United States Department of Defense 15 16 recently indicated that the closing of the Duluth Air Force Base will be announced within the present year; and 17 1.8 WHEREAS, this closing will have an economic impact of thirty-two million dollars upon all of northeastern Minnesota and further reduce the state's share of national 21 military expenditures; now, therefore,
