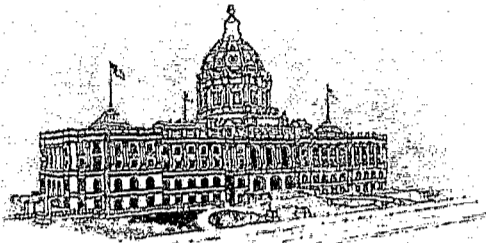

## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION No. 10

1                   A house concurrent resolution  
2           relating to the delivery of bills to the governor  
3           after final adjournment.

4  
5           BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives, the  
6   Senate concurring, that on adjournment sine die of the 70th  
7   regular session of the Legislature, bills shall be presented  
8   to the Governor in conformity with the provisions of this  
9   resolution and as follows:

10           (a) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives,  
11   the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, the  
12   President of the Senate, and the Secretary of the Senate  
13   shall certify and sign each bill in the same manner and upon  
14   the same certification as each bill is signed for  
15   presentation to the Governor prior to adjournment sine die,  
16   and each of those officers shall continue in his designated  
17   capacity during the three days following the date of final  
18   adjournment:

19           (b) That the Chief Clerk of the House of  
20   Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate in  
21   accordance with the rules of the respective bodies and under

1 the supervision and direction of the standing Committee on  
 2 Rules and Legislative Administration and the standing  
 3 Committee on Rules and Administration shall carefully  
 4 engross and enroll each bill and make delivery thereof to  
 5 the Governor in the same manner as each bill is engrossed  
 6 and enrolled and delivered to the Governor prior to the  
 7 adjournment of the Legislature sine die;

8 (c) That the Revisor of Statutes shall continue to  
 9 assist in all of the functions relating to the engrossment  
 10 and enrollment of bills of the House of Representatives and  
 11 of the Senate under the supervision of the Chief Clerk of  
 12 the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate  
 13 in the same manner that his assistance was rendered prior to  
 14 the adjournment of the Legislature sine die;

15 (d) That this concurrent resolution is enacted in  
 16 accordance with the requirements of the Constitution,  
 17 Article IV, Section 23; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Clerk of the  
 19 House of Representatives deliver a copy of this Resolution  
 20 to the Governor, and the Secretary of State.
