WHEREAS: during this week this Association will celebrate its sixth biennial national convention, with Swan Lake Lodge, Pengilly, Minnesota, serving as host; and


WHEREAS: representatives of 90 chapters of the Junior National Association of the Deaf throughout the United States will attend this convention;




