RESOLUTION APPROVING PROPOSED ANNEXATION


WHEREAS, Herbert Warring and Maxine Warring have filed with the City their Petition for Annexation of the following described property, to-wit:

Commencing in the center of the public highway at a point 12.5 rods northeasterly from a point on the East and West Quarter line of Section 28, Township 36, Range 23, 32.5 rods East of the Southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section; thence East and parallel with the East and West Quarter line, 264 feet; thence North and parallel with the West line of the right of way of the Eastern Railway Company of Minnesota, a distance of 39 feet; thence East and parallel with the said East and West Quarter line of said Section, a distance of 785.4 feet to the West line of said right of way of the Eastern Railway Company of Minnesota; thence Northeasterly along the said West line of said right of way a distance of 122.5 feet; thence West and parallel with the East and West Quarter line of said Section 1049 feet to the center of the public highway as there located; thence Southwesterly following the center of said highway a distance of 168.5 feet to point of commencement, and there to terminate, excepting therefrom highway easements of record, EXCEPTING, however, the westerly 264 feet of the within described tract.



ORDINANCE NO. 180

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE, ISANTI COUNTY,
MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND
NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated September 30, 1977, requesting annexation of the territory described below, was duly presented to the council and filed in the office of the City Clerk on 1977; and

WHEREAS, said petition for annexation was duly signed by all of the owners of the property described below pursuant to the statutes made and provided in such cases; and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of said Petition for Annexation was filed in the office of the Township Clerk of the Township of Cambridge on October 25, 1977, in the office of the County Auditor in and for Isanti County, Minnesota, on October 25, 1977 (the said Township and County being the same in which all of the lands to be annexed is located); and with the Minnesota Municipal Commission on October 25, 1977; and

WHEREAS, more than sixty (60) days have elapsed since said Petition has been filed with the said Cambridge Township, Auditor of Isanti County, and Minnesota Municipal Commission, and no written objections to the annexation from any municipal subdivision or person has been filed or submitted to the City of Cambridge or the Minnesota Municipal Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the annexation of the territory hereinafter described will be to the best interest of the City of Cambridge and of the territory affected and that said territory is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF CAMBRIDGE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Declarations. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the City of Cambridge and is so conditioned as to properly be subjected to city government, and that the annexation thereof would be to the best interest of the City of Cambridge and the territory affected.


Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Cambridge are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing in the center of the public highway at a point 12.5 rods northeasterly from a point on the East and West Quarter line of Section 28, Township 36, Range 23, 32.5 rods East of the Southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section; thence East and parallel with the East and West Quarter line, 264 feet; thence North and parallel with the West line of the right-of-way of the Eastern Railway Company of Minnesota, a distance of 39 feet; thence East and parallel with the said East and West Quarter line of said Section, a distance of 785.4 feet to the West line of said right-of-way of the Eastern Railway Company of Minnesota; thence Northeasterly along the said West line of said right-of-way a distance of 122.5 feet; thence West and parallel with the East and West Quarter line of said Section 1049 feet to the center of the public highway as there located; thence Southwesterly following the center of said highway a distance of 168.5 feet to point of commencement, and there to terminate, excepting therefrom highway easements of record, EXCEPTING, however, the westerly 264 feet of the within described tract.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the office of the Secretary of the State of Minnesota, in the office of the Minnesota Municipal Commission, in the office of the Isanti County Auditor, and with the Cambridge Town Clerk, all pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.033 Subdivision 7.


Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3, hereof.

(3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the village of Cambridge in the County of Isanti and it has its known office of issue in the village of Cambridge in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by managing officer of said newspaper or persons in its employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by managing officer of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

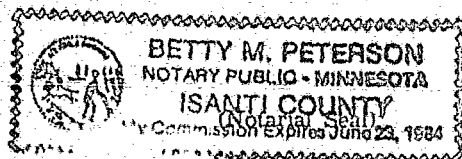
