


Proclamation


- WHEREAS: *the Alumni Association of Shattuck School was organized in June, 1878; and*
- WHEREAS: *the object of the society, known as The Old Shads' Association, is to bind its graduates more closely in bonds of fellowship and to link them to their Alma Mater; and*
- WHEREAS: *Shattuck graduates have made distinguished records in the State and the Nation and throughout the world as artists, actors, authors, businessmen, clergymen, diplomats, educators, editors, industrialists and leaders in all branches of the Armed Forces and in government; and*
- WHEREAS: *this centennial year will be celebrated with an All-Class Reunion, June 9, 10 and 11, 1978; and*
- WHEREAS: *since Shattuck School, founded in 1858, is closely linked with the early days of Minnesota history, it is appropriate that both Minnesota and Shattuck should observe this centennial year of 1978;*
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 4, 1978 to be
