WHEREAS: June 14 has been recognized as "Fly the Flag Day" and has been observed over the nation with the flying of the American flag; and

WHEREAS: there is increased interest in the flying of the flag as a symbol of the greatness of our country; and

WHEREAS: the ideals of America insure the orderly procedures of justice in the competing ideologies of the present and will hold in balance the pledge of liberty and freedom for the future; and

WHEREAS: the flying of the flag on a continuous basis is a reminder for our people to keep alive the Spirit of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 14, 1978 to be

FLY THE FLAG DAY

in Minnesota.
