


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, August 16, 1978 to be

MINNESOTA TRAPPERS DAY


in recognition of the Association's efforts on behalf of wildlife, the sportsman and the fur industry
