WHEREAS: there are over 8,000 persons who are actively involved in the concrete and masonry industry in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota Concrete and Masonry Contractors Association, in conjunction with the Minnesota Masonry Institute, is coordinating its sixth annual project to promote public awareness of the versatility, economy and aesthetics of concrete and masonry products in meeting community needs; and
