- 3. The City of Rochester is capable of providing the services required by the area described herein within a reasonable time.
- 4. The mill levy of the annexing municipality on the area proposed for annexation should be increased in substantially equal proportions over a three year period.
- 5. An order should be issued by the Minnesota Municipal Board annexing the area described herein.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property lying in the Township of Cascade, County of Olmsted, State of Minnesota, be and the same hereby is annexed to the City of Rochester the same as if it has originally been made a part thereof:

> Commencing at a point 364.82 feet North of the South 1/4 Corner Section, running thence North 1,945 feet to a point 330 feet South of Center Section, thence East 176.23 feet to the West line of Trunk Highway U. S. 52, thence South 1,945 feet to a point 364.82 feet North of South line Section, thence West 164.76 feet to the point of beginning, less 1.53 acres to standforth, and including half the adjacent rightof-way of Trunk Highway U. S. 52, Section 34, Township 107 North, Range 14 West, Cascade Township, containing 6.18 acres.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the mill levy of the City of Rochester on the property herein ordered annexed shall be increased in substantially equal proportions over a period of three years to equality with the mill levy of the property already within the City.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is June 6, 1978.
