


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 22 and 23, 1978 to be

451st ARMY BAND DAYS


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to appreciate its music and recognize the Army Reserve's importance to the welfare and security of the state and nation.
