

## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Memory is the first cow ever to "go on the road" to promote her own product, milk, nature's most nearly perfect food; and

WHEREAS: Memory has completed her "March for Milk" that has taken her from the Canadian border to the Mexican border and through 13 states in the U.S.; and

WHEREAS: "Memory's March for Milk" has brought national attention to the contributions made by dairy foods, the dairy cow, the dairy farmer and the entire dairy and agricultural community to the United States' growth and development; and

WHEREAS: "Memory's March for Milk" has brought particular attention to her home state of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 30, 1978 to be

MEMORY'S MARCH FOR MILK DAY

in Minnesota, and do encourage all our citizens to "Make Memory Happy--Be Bullish on Milk".
