Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota has long adhered to the philosophy that art and culture are vital to our high quality of life; and

WHEREAS: a prime state commitment, both public and private, has been to ensure that art work and cultural activities are available to all citizens across the state; and

WHEREAS: fulfilling the commitment entails the delivery of such opportunities statewide; and

WHEREAS: "Rolling Colors" represents a traveling eight-ton art work which reflects Minnesota's spirit of pioneerism, hard work and individual initiative;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 30, 1978 to be

KINETIC ART DAY

in Minnesota and hereby extend special congratulations to artist Bob Lesch and to Christor Malmgren, whose rolling canvas will carry Minnesota art and Minnesota's spirit throughout the state and across the nation.
