Ordinance Number 101

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WINTHROP TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

(William Groehler Property)

WHEREAS, A certain petition dated October 6, 1977, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the City Council on the 6th day of October, 1977; and

WHEREAS, The quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately one-half acre of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated City; and

WHEREAS, The petition was signed by two owners, constituting all of the owners, thereof; and

WHEREAS, The resolution of the Town Board of Alfsborg Township has been received, waiving all objections to the annexation of said land and waiving the sixty (60) day notice period thereof; and

WHEREAS, The land described in the petition abutts upon the City limits at the Southeasterly boundaries thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Winthrop, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be in the best interests of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abutts upon the City limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; (3) that none of the said territory is now included within the limits of any City.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described hereinafter and made a part hereof and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof. The land hereinabove mentioned is described as:

Beginning at a point 570.8 feet West and 171 feet 8 inches South of the center of Section 6, Township 112, Range 29, thence due South 66 feet 8 inches; thence West 142 feet, more or less, to the East right-of-way line of Sibley County State Aid Road No. 1 as the same is now laid out and situated; thence North along the East right-of-way line of said Sibley County State Aid Road No. 1 for a distance of 66 feet 8 inches; thence due East 142 feet, more or less, to and terminating at the given point of beginning.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk of Alfsborg Township and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
