WHEREAS: *there are thousands of children and adults in the state of Minnesota with special learning disabilities; and*

WHEREAS: *these persons are of normal intelligence, but are handicapped by a disorder in one or more of the basic learning patterns involved in understanding or in using language; and*

WHEREAS: *the Minnesota Association for Children with Learning Disabilities is a non-profit organization dedicated to the advancement of the education and general welfare of these children and adults; and*

WHEREAS: *a state-wide campaign to inform the public about this special problem has been planned for the month of October;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1978 to be
