"That Chapter XIV, Sub-Chapter II, Part I, Section 144 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Mankato, Slue Earth County, Minnesota, be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:

· The city is hereby authorized to grade, pave, repave, curb, gutter, wall, bridge, gravel, macadamize, sprinkle, plank, sweep or repair any street, evenue, alley or highway; to grade improve, protect and ornament any public park, square, or grounds: to construct, improve and ornament parkways, and grass plats: to plant and protect shade or ornamental trees along its streets and avenues; to construct, lay, relay and repair sidewalks, retaining walls, gutters, sewers, drains and water mains, in, over, or under any street, alley or highway; to abate nuisances; to drain marshes, swamps and low grounds within the city when they constitute a nuisance; and the whole or any part of the expense of any such improvement may be, subject to the provisions hereinafter contained, defrayed by an assessment upon the real estate benefited thereby, in proportion to such benefits, without regard to cash valuation, to be determined and levied in the manner hereinafter provided. .

And that Section 215, 216, 217, and 218, being "Chapter XV - WATER WORKS", of the said Home Rule Charter of the City of Mankato, be repealed."
