

## Proclamation

WHEREAS: the Twin City Society of X-ray Technicians met on March 8, 1938 to accept the Bylaws and Constitution for the American Society of Radiologic Technologists and to establish all affiliated societies of radiologic technologists under a uniform foundation; and

WHEREAS: the committee met again for organization in November 1938 at the home of Alfred Greene, R.T. (ARRT) to make plans for the first meeting; and

WHEREAS: the new Minnesota Society of Radiologic Technologists, embracing the Twin City Society of X-ray Technicians and the Arrowhead Society with 47 members, became recognized as an affiliate society of the American Society of Radiologic Technologists on December 10, 1938; and

WHEREAS: the 2,500 Registered Radiologic Technologists of the State of Minnesota have recognized the need for continued professional growth and education in the exchange of technical information to better the patient care; and

WHEREAS: the dedication of these people has stood in testimony of their concern for improved patient care through radiation protection, continuing education and need for exchange of information for forty years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 1 through October 8, 1978 to be
