AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WINTHROP TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ADJUTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

(Roose Property)

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated June 6, 1977, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the City Council on the 6th day of June, 1977; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately one half acre of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by two owners, constituting all of the owners thereof; and

WHEREAS, the resolution of the Town Board of Aitahong Township has been received waiving all objections to the annexation of said land and waiving the 60 day notice period thereof; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the southeasterly boundaries thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Winthrop, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be in the ~~best interests of the City~~ of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of the said territory is now included within the limits of any city.

Section 2. Territory ~~within the~~ corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described hereinafter and made a part thereof and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof. The land hereinafter mentioned is described as:

Beginning at a point 307.5 feet east and 105 feet South of the center of Section 6, Township 113, Range 23, Sibley County, Minnesota; thence due South 60 feet 8 inches; thence due West 142 feet, more or less, to the East right-of-way line of Sibley County State Aid Road No. 1 as the same now exists and situated; thence North along the East right-of-way line of said Sibley County State Aid Road No. 1 for a distance of 60 feet 8 inches; and thence due East 142 feet, more or less, to and terminating at the given point of beginning.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, The Town Clerk of Aitahong Township and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
