WHEREAS: Honeywell has performed an important and symbolic service to the people of this state; and


WHEREAS: in 1978, Honeywell, Inc. is continuing in its effort to keep Minnesota a number one state in voter interest and turnout;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, August 4, 1978 to be

HONEYWELL, INC. DAY


in Minnesota in gratitude for its active concern for citizen participation in the political process.
