



Proclamation

WHEREAS: on March 3, 1978, House Joint Resolution 773 was introduced in the House of Representatives proclaiming "National Port Week". The purpose of the Resolution is to bring to the attention of the American people the contributions that our ocean and inland ports have had in expanding our development as a great trading nation; and

WHEREAS: recognition is due for our port communities because we are the greatest importing and exporting nation in the world and will be even more so in the future; and

WHEREAS: the ports presently provide employment for over one million Americans, add five billion dollars to the U.S. Treasury, and one billion to our balance of payments;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through September 24, 1978 to be

in Minnesota.
