WHEREAS: the foundation of our nation's economy is the ability of our citizens to buy back the fruits of their labor; and

WHEREAS: the Union Labels, Shop Cards, Store Cards and Service Buttons of the organizations of American labor are symbols of good working conditions, fair wages and increased security brought to workers through the achievements of the trade union movement and the process of collective bargaining; and

WHEREAS: the American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial Organizations and its national Union Label and Service Trades Department have designated the period of September 4-10, 1978 as Union Label Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 4 through September 10, 1978 to be
