WHEREAS: *on October 7, special chess events are being held in Minnesota and throughout the Nation; and*

WHEREAS: *the United States Chess Federation has proclaimed this day as Chess Day in the United States of America;*


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, October 7, 1978 to be

CHESS DAY

in Minnesota, and call upon all Minnesota chessplayers to join in the observance by participating in some sort of activity.


FURTHERMORE, I proclaim that henceforth the first Saturday in October shall continue to be known as Chess Day in Minnesota and similarly observed.
