WHEREAS: *the State of Minnesota has established the policy of state support for services designed to protect and improve people's health within their own community with the passage of this Community Health Services Act of 1976; and*

WHEREAS: *the Act focuses on programs designed to prevent disease, to promote health and to provide alternatives to institutional care; and*

WHEREAS: *state and local government officials and their citizen advisors have worked cooperatively to develop and maintain an integrated system of community health services under local administration with state guidelines and standards; and*


WHEREAS: *the state recognizes the outstanding achievements of local and state government officials and advisory committees in developing community health services in eighty Minnesota counties since 1976;*

in Minnesota.




