WHEREAS: there is a need to interpret the many choices and vocational guidance services available to the public; and


WHEREAS: National Career Guidance Week stresses this need as an annual focal point in these efforts because it brings concentrated attention to the importance and values of career education;

NATIONAL CAREER GUIDANCE WEEK




