

Proclamation


- WHEREAS: physical therapists who practice in Minnesota's hospitals, schools, nursing homes, private offices and home care agencies have an important role in the efficient delivery of good health care; and
- WHEREAS: physical therapy helps to restore useful movement and physical independence to individuals following injury or disease; and
- WHEREAS: physical therapists, through emphasis on continuing education to update their knowledge, are realizing a need for preventative and curative health care at a reasonable cost; and
- WHEREAS: physical therapists are registered by the State Board of Medical Examiners after national testing and upon receipt of their degree which follows four to six years of university or graduate level training; and
- WHEREAS: there are currently 900 registered physical therapists in Minnesota, approximately 500 of which are members of their professional organization, the Minnesota Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association;




PHYSICAL THERAPY WEEK
