ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS  
OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:


Section 1. That pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.033, the City Council of the City of Watertown, having prior heretofore accepted a Petition for Annexation into the corporate limits of the City of Watertown by all of the property owners of those certain lands as hereinafter set forth and copies of said Petition having been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Watertown, the Carver County Board of Commissioners, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, on March 2, 1978, as required by law and the rules of the Minnesota Municipal Board, and more than 90 days having elapsed since such filing and no written objections having been made, or otherwise, and the Council having determined that said lands abut the present corporate limits of the City of Watertown, do not exceed 200 acres, are now urban or suburban in character, and are conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government and that annexation of said lands would be to the best interests of the City of Watertown and the lands to be annexed, the corporate limits of the City of Watertown are declared hereby extended to encompass and include all that certain land described as follows:

Tracts A, B, C, D, and E, Registered Land Survey No. 36, according to the files of the Carver County Register of Titles; and the easterly one-half (1/2) of the township road (Newton Avenue) as now located adjoining and abutting the westerly line of Tracts A and E of said Registered Land Survey No. 36.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Town Clerk of the Town of Watertown, the Carver County Auditor, and the Minnesota Secretary of State and to publish this Ordinance in the Carver County News, all as required by law.

Adopted by the City Council of the City of Watertown this 1st day of August, 1978.




