WHEREAS: *total involvement of community and schools will maintain our high level of education in the state of Minnesota; and*


WHEREAS: *these concerns are reflected in the 1978 national theme--EDUCATION CAN TURN THINGS AROUND--which also suits Minnesota;*



EDUCATION WEEK


in Minnesota, and urge all to reaffirm their commitment to improving education on all levels, and to translate that commitment into action by visiting local schools.
