


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, September 19, 1978 to be

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to attend and fully appreciate the benefits of the Science Museum of Minnesota.


