WHEREAS: the Beltrami County Council on Chemical Dependency has planned a festival to celebrate the enjoyment of life without the use of alcohol and drugs; and


WHEREAS: the above celebration has been named the North Country Freedom Fest and is scheduled to be held on September 15 and 16, 1978;



NORTH COUNTRY FREEDOM FEST DAYS


in Minnesota.
