AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND TO THE CITY OF LITTLEFORK

WHEREAS, a petition has been duly filed pursuant to Minnesota Statute Sec. 414.033 to have the real estate hereinafter described annexed to the City of Littlefork, Minnesota;

WHEREAS, said petition was signed by all of the owners of said real estate and duly filed with the City Council of Littlefork, Minnesota; the Koochiching County, Minnesota, Board of County Commissioners; and the Minnesota Municipal Board; and said real estate is unincorporated land abutting the City of Littlefork, is not included in any other municipality, does not abut or border on any other town, other municipality, or organized township, and is unplatted and it does not exceed 200 acres; and

WHEREAS, Koochiching County Board have waived and agreed to not object to such

annexation; and
