WHEREAS: the elected officials of this State have, since early statehood, expanded suffrage and encouraged increased voter participation; and

WHEREAS: the League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan organization dedicated to promoting the active and informed participation of citizens in their government; and

WHEREAS: the League of Women Voters of Minnesota has served the citizens of this State by providing impartial information on candidates and voting for almost 60 years; and

WHEREAS: members of the League of Women Voters of Minnesota have assisted citizens, organizations and local governmental units by registering voters; and

WHEREAS: the League of Women Voters of Minnesota has further assisted citizens with political responsibility through its educational and legislative action programs; and


WHEREAS: it is fitting that at this time recognition be given to these achievements which have strengthened and improved representative government in Minnesota;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1978 to be


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to join with me in honoring the League of Women Voters for their efforts in education and in encouraging increased citizen participation in their government.
