WHEREAS: the Twin Cities Chapter of APICS reflects through its deeds and accomplishments in members' business and educational communities the objectives of the international society; and


WHEREAS: the week of October 23-27, 1978 has been designated as National Production and Inventory Control Week;



AMERICAN PRODUCTION AND INVENTORY CONTROL WEEK


in Minnesota.
