
Dear Sir:-

You will please take notice, that the undersigned, will, within 30 days, file an application in the General Land Office, at Washington, D. C., for the survey of that certain unsurveyed Island located in Sand Point Lake, St. Louis County, Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

An unsurveyed Island located in the central portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 68 North, Range 17 West, 4th P.M., lying due South 675 feet from M.C. No. 45 on the extreme Northwest corner of Lot 1 of said Section, containing approximately 3.75 acres.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit, tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Island should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
