WHEREAS: Minnesota has made great progress in the fields of medicine, engineering and other areas with a view toward the betterment of mankind; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota proudly recognizes that each nation and ethnic group has made great progress and shared this progress with all mankind;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, October 24, 1978 to be

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be supportive of their fellow men and sensitive to their needs. Let us invite all nations of the world to share with us in Mankind's recognition of its Dignity.
