

A PETITION FOR CALLING AN ELECTION FOR DETERMINATION  
OF THE PROPOSED INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF GULLY,  
IN POLK COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners in and for Polk County,  
Minnesota.

Gentlemen:-

We, the undersigned, who are twenty five (25) or more of the voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, in compliance with the provisions of section 1304 and 1305, of chapter nine (9) of the General statutes of Minnesota, for the year 1913, and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, respectfully petition the Board of County Commissioners of Polk County, Minnesota, that being the county in which the whole of said lands hereinafter described are situated, to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation of the territory hereinafter described to become the Village of GULLY, Polk County, Minnesota.

We respectfully represent that we have caused to be taken a census of the resident population of the territory hereinafter described, which said census is hereto attached and made as much a part of this petition as if the same were herein fully written and have found that the number of actual residents living within the territory hereinafter described to be 180. That the census mentioned and referred to and made a part of this petition was taken between the 28th day of April, 1924 and the 28th day of April, 1924, that being within eight (8) weeks from the date of the presentation of this petition to the County Board of Polk County, Minnesota.

That the boundaries of the territory proposed to be incorporated are as follows: beginning at a point eighty (80) rods south of the section corner common to sections twenty six (26), ~~twenty seven (27)~~, thirty four (34) and thirty five (35) all in township one hundred fifty (150) North of Range thirty nine (39) west of the 5th principal meridian, thence running due east a distance of eighty (80) rods, thence running due south a distance of one hundred sixty (160) rods, thence running due west a distance of one hundred sixty (160) rods, thence running due north a distance of one hundred sixty (160) rods, and thence running due east a distance of eighty (80) rods to the point of beginning. That the premises within the boundaries hereinbefore described and set forth and within the limits of the proposed incorporated village is more definitely described as follows, to wit, the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section thirty five (35), and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section thirty four (34), all in township one hundred fifty (150) North of Range thirty nine (39) west of the 5th principal, containing 160 acres of land, be the same more or less, according to the United States Government survey thereof.

That the name of the village proposed to be incorporated shall be the Village of Gully, Polk County, Minnesota.

Your petitioners further respectfully ask the Board of County

Commissioners of said Polk County, Minnesota, to approve this petition and proceed as provided for by law to call an election and to do such acts and cause the same to be done, as required by law to incorporate the territory hereinbefore described into a village.

## RESOLUTION.

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Polk and State of Minnesota, held at the Commissioners' office at the Court House in the City of Graceton, County of Polk and State of Minnesota, on the 20th day of May, 1904, County Commissioner Grundysen offered the following resolution which was duly seconded by Commissioner Driscoll.

Whereas, a petition signed by Frank A. Horgquist and twenty eight other voters and residents of the territory described in their petition, on this day presented to said Board of County Commissioners, petitioning said Board of County Commissioners to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation of the Village of Gully, Polk County, Minnesota,

And, whereas, said petition in all things complies with the provisions of sections 1804 and 1805, of Chapter 9, of the General Statutes of Minnesota for 1903, and acts amendatory and supplemental to said sections, and said petitioners presented at the same time as presenting said petition a census of the resident population living and residing within the territory proposed to be incorporated, and the said Board being advised in the premises;

BE IT RESOLVED That said petition for the incorporation of said Village of Gully, Polk County, Minnesota, be approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the question as to whether or not the territory described in said petition shall be incorporated into the Village of Gully be submitted to the voters residing within the territorial limits of the proposed incorporation at an election to be held on the 28th day of June, 1904, within the territorial limits of said proposed incorporated village; and that said election shall be held at the public Hall in the town of Gully, Polk County, Minnesota, on the 28th day of June, 1904; that said election shall be conducted so far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers. That Frank A. Horgquist, Dr. A. Shedler and H. Low, voters and residents within the proposed incorporated territory be and they are hereby appointed inspectors of said election; and that said inspectors shall act as judges of election.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That a copy of said petition with the notice attached stating the time and place of holding such election as hereinafore set forth be posted in three public places within the boundary of said proposed incorporation. And that said petition and notice of election also be published in a qualified newspaper within said limits by two weeks published notice thereof. And that said copies of said petition and notice <sup>be</sup> posted at least twenty (20) days prior to the said election.

Upon the roll call of yea and nay the vote stood as follows. Those voting in the affirmative were, Commissioners, Christianson, F.H. Ross, Theo. Garvik, D. Grundysen and James Duiscoll. Commissioners voting in the negative were none. Upon this vote the resolution was declared to be adopted by the chairman.
