AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN  
LAND TO THE CITY OF MANKATO

WHEREAS, William B. Webb and H. Bert Looney, as owners have filed with and presented to the City Council of the City of Mankato a petition to annex property;

AND WHEREAS, such tract or parcel is not incorporated or included within any other municipality, abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Mankato on the southerly boundary thereof, and is not platted and does not exceed 200 acres in area;

AND WHEREAS, no objections to the proposed annexation have been received by the City of Mankato from the Town Board of Mankato Township, the County Board of Blue Earth County, or any governing body of any municipality upon whose boundaries such tract or parcel abuts;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Mankato:

- 1) That the annexation requested by such petition will be to the best interests of the City of Mankato and the territory affected by such annexation;
- 2) That the tract or parcel described below abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Mankato and, will be urban or suburban in character;
- 3) That no portion of such tract or parcel is now included within the limits of any municipality;
- 4) That the corporate limits of the City of Mankato shall be extended to include the unplatted land described as follows:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 30-108-26, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the North line of said Section 30, 908.0 feet East of the Northwest corner thereof; thence due East along said North line a distance of 295.1 feet; thence running South 2°32' West, a distance of 403.3 feet to the right of way line of a public highway; thence running Northwesterly along said right of way line a distance of 266 feet; thence running North 35°58 1/2' East a distance of 123.6 feet; thence running North 49° 38 3/4' West, a distance of 196.3 feet to the place of beginning. ALSO, commencing at a point 5 rods East of the Northwest corner of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 30, thence due South on a line parallel with the Westerly line of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 30 to the center line of the public road which is now located in said East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 30, thence Northwesterly along the center line of public highway to a point where said center line intersects the Westerly line of said East Half of the Northwest Quarter of


Section 30, thence Northerly on said Westerly line to the Northwest corner of said East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 30 and thence East 5 rods to place of beginning.


and that the above-described land shall be annexed to and included within the City of Mankato as effectively as if originally a part thereof.

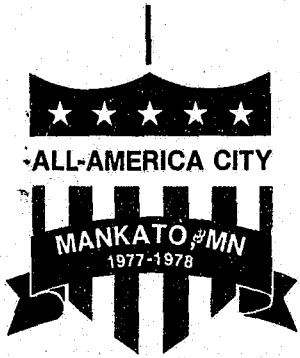
- 5) That, the City Clerk shall be and hereby is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Blue Earth County Auditor, and the Mankato Town Board.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after adoption.


