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## ORDINANCE NO. 77-3-21

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LONG PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, PLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, certain petitions dated November 1, 1976, and February 4, 1977, requesting annexation of territory hereinafter described, was duly presented to the Council on the <u>7th</u> day of <u>February</u>, 1977, and

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WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petitions and bounded as described is less than two hundred (200) acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the petitions were signed by all the owners of said property, and,

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has waived any and all objections on its part to the annexation, and

WHEREAS, copies of said petitions were filed with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the County Auditor of Todd County and the Town Clerk of Long Prairie Township on February 15, 1977, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petitions abuts upon the city limits at the south boundary thereof,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG PRAIRIE, MINNESOTA,

ORDAINS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines:

- (a) That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City and of the territory affected.
- (b) That the territory described herein abuts the city limits and is urban or suburban in character.
- (c) That none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed: The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part hereof:

> Lots Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) of Block Two (2), and Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) of Block Three (3), Kendon Addition to the City of Long Prairie, according to the plat thereof, on file and of record at the office of the County Recorder, Todd County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The City Administrator is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesora Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage, publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
