WHEREAS: December 7 recalls a day that Americans will never forget and whose significance must be taught to our youth; and


WHEREAS: the Pearl Harbor survivors stand as a living testimony of our continuing obligation to be prepared to defend ourselves;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, December 7, 1978 to be


## PEARL HARBOR REMEMBRANCE DAY
