




SPLIT LIQUOR

Currently the city operates and intends to continue to operate a municipal liquor store. Shall the City of Madison Lake in addition be authorized to issue private "on-sale" licenses to hotels and restaurants as defined in Minnesota statutes. Section 340.07?

there were 117 votes in favor of the proposition, 96 votes against the proposition, and one ballots were illegible, spoiled or otherwise defective and the proposition is hereby declared carried by more than the required majority vote.
