



Proclamation



- WHEREAS: their efforts and dedication should not go unrecognized;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 1 through December 4, 1978 to be

CIVIL AIR PATROL WEEK


in Minnesota, in recognition of the efforts of the volunteer members of the Minnesota Wing, Civil Air Patrol.
