FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

The above-entitled matter came on for hearing before the Minnesota Municipal Board pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414, as amended, on July 22, 1977, and December 7, 1977, at Herman, Minnesota. The hearing was conducted by Thomas Simmons, Board Member, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.01 , Subd. 12. The petitioners were represented by Mr. Peter Smilde and Mr. Dewey Nelson; the City was represented by Mr. Lyndon Kratochwill. Testimony was heard and records and exhibits were received.

After due and careful consideration of all evidence, together with all records, files and proceedings, the Minnesota Municipal Board hereby makes and files the following findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order,

## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That a petition was duly filed with the Municipal Board on April 19, 1977, by all the property owners requesting detachment from the City of Norcross.
2. The petition contained all the information required by statute including a description of the territory proposed for detachment which is as follows:

The Northwest Quarter (NW -1, 1) of Section Thirty-four (34), Township One Twenty -eight (128) North, Range Forty-four (44) West, comprising 143.96acres more or less.

The West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W-1/2SW-1/4) of Section Twenty -seven (27), Township One Twenty-cight (128) North, Range Forty -four (44) West, of the principal Meridian.

That part of the South Half ( $S-1 / 2$ ) of Section Twenty -eight (28), Township One Twenty-eight (128) North, Range Forty -four (44) West, lying South and West of the right-of-way of the Great Northern Railway and lying South and East of the center line of Griswold Street of the Village of Norcross extended to the South line of said Section 28 except that portion known as Lane's Addition of the Village of Norcross and also excepting two (2) acres described as follows to-wit: Begimning at the intersection of the center line of Griswold Street of the Village of Norcross. produced with the section line of the South side of said Section 28, thence runing North $23^{\circ} 30^{\prime \prime}$ East along the center line of Griswold Street 34.17 rods, thence South $66^{\circ} 30^{\prime \prime}$ East 10 rods, thence South $23^{\circ} 30^{\prime \prime}$ West 29.83 rods to said Section line, thence West along said section line to place of beginning.

The West llalf (W-1/2) of the West lalf (W-1/2) of the Northwest Quarter: (NW-1/4) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township One Twenty-eight (1.28) Norch, Range [rorty -four (44) West, comprising 40 acres.

The Southeast Quarter (SE-1/4) of Section Twenty -one (21), Township One Twenty-eight (128) Noith, Range Forty-four (44) West, comprising 160 acres;

The South Half (S $-1 / 2$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $-1 / 4$ ), Section Twenty -two (22), Township One Twenty-eight (128) North, Range Forty-four (44) West, comprising 80 acres;

That part of the Northeast Quarter (NE-1/4) of Section Twenty eight (28), Township One Twenty-eight (128) North, Range Forty -four (44) West, lying North and East of the right-of -way of the St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba Railway as now located except the town site of Norcross and except a triangular body of land containing twelve (12) acres situate at the angle formed by the intersection of said right -of-way with the Northwest boundary line of said town site of Norcross, said excepted tract being bounded on the Southeast by said boundary line of said town site on the Southwest by said right of -way and on the North by a line drawn between said boundary line of Norcross and said right-of-way parallel with the North line of said Section 28, the tract hereby described containing exclusive of said excepted tract 217 acres and 18 square rods more or less acconding to the government survey and said tract in said Section 28 hereby conveyed being further described by the following magnctic courses ruming by the magnetic needle without correction of the variation to-wit, beginning at a point 3.41 chains South $80^{\circ}$ West from the Northeast corner of said Section 28 , ruming thence South $13^{\circ} 45^{\prime \prime}$ West 22.47 chains, thence South $80^{\circ}$ West 15.98 chains to the right -of -way of the St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba Ralload, thence North $12^{\circ}$ West 24.50 chains along the line of said right-of-way, thence North $80^{\circ}$ East 38.09 chains to the point of beginning, comprising 57 acres more or less.
3. The area proposed for detachment is situated within the City of Norcross
and abuts the municipal boundary
4. The area proposed for detachment is 612 acres.
5. The area proposed for detachment is unplatted and occupied and used primarily
for agricultural purposes.
6. The number and character of buildings on the concerned area are as follows:
farm house and farm buildings.
7. Municipal improvements in the area are: a "winter road" running north and south and touchingmost of the property involved and a drainage ditch along this same road.
8. The population of the area subject to detachment is 6.
9. The area abuts the township of Gorton.
10. The adoption of a reasonable rural service taxing district would best serve the affected area and Norcross.

1. The Minnesota Municipal Board july acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.
2. Detachment would not unreasonably affect the symmetry of Maynard.
3. Detachment may adversely affect anticipated future development.
4. An order should be issued by the Minnesota Municipal Board conditionally detaching the area described herein.

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That, if a reasonable rural service taxing district is not created by this order's effective date, the following-described property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Norcross and made a part of the Township of Gorton, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

The Northwest Quarter (NW-1/4) of Section Thirty -four (34), Township One Twenty -eight (128) North, Range Forty -four ( $\ddagger 4$ ) West, comprising 143.96acres more or less.

The West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W-1/2 SW -1/4) of Section Twonity -seven (27), Township One Twenty -eight (128) North, Range Forty-four (44) West, of the principal Meridian.

That part of the South Half (S-1,2) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One Twenty -eight (128) North, Range Forty -four (44) West, lying South and West of the right-of-way of the Great Northern Railway and lying South and East of the center line of Griswold Street of the Village of Norcross extended to the South line of said Section 28 except that portion known as Lane's Addition of the Village of Norcross and also excepting two (2) acres described as follows to-wit: Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Griswold Street of the Village of Norcross produced with the section line of the South side of said Section 28 , thence runing North $23^{\circ} 30^{\circ}$ East along the center line of Griswold Street 34.17 rods, thence South $66^{\circ} 30^{\prime \prime}$ East 10 rods, thence South $23^{\circ} 30^{\prime \prime}$ West 29.83 rods to said Section line, thence West along said Section line to place of beginning.

That part of the Northeast Quarter (N E-1/4) of Section Twenty eight (28), Township Ono Twenty -eight (128) North, Range Forty -four (44) West, lying North and East of the tight-of-way of the St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba Railway as now located except the town site of Norcross and except a triangular body of land containing twelve (1.2) acres situate at the angle formed by the intersection of said right -o f-way with the Northwest boundary line of said town site of Norcross, said excepted tract being bounded on the Southeast by said boundary line of said town site on the Southwest by said right -of -way and on the North by a line drawn between sadi boundary line of Norcross and said right-of-way parallel with the North line of said Section 28 , the tract hereby described containing exclusive of said excepted tract 21.7 acres and 18 square rods more or less according to the government survey and said tract in said Section 28 hereby conveyed being further described by the following magnetic courses running by the magnetic needle without correction of the variation to-wit, beginning at a point 3.41 chains South $80^{\circ}$ West from the Northeast corner of said Section 28 , fuming thence South $13^{\circ} 45^{\prime \prime}$ West 22.47 chains, thence South $80^{\circ}$ West 15.98 chains to the right-of-way of the St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba Railroad, thence North $42^{\circ}$ West 24.50 chains along the line of said right-of-way, thence North $80^{\circ}$ Last 38.09 chains to the point of beginning, comprising 57 acres more or less.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That if a reasonable rural service taxing district is
established, subject to review by the Municipal Board, the detachment petition shall
be dismissed.
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is November 16, 1979.
