
Special Census

"On motion of Recorder Golob supported by Trustee Brownell the Village Recorder was authorized and instructed to correspond with the Secretary of State requesting him, at the earliest possible time to take immediate steps relative to making a Special Census of the annexed portion of the Village of Hibbing formerly known as Kitzville".
(Unanimous)

The Council earnestly requests your immediate action in regard to this matter, calling your attention to Section #3 of Chapter 417, Laws of 1921. This territory was annexed to the Village of Hibbing in the month of March, 1924. There is a population there of approximately from five to six hundred people and this would make a material difference in our next levy because of the Per Capita Law under which this Village is governed.
