Detroit Lakes ORDINANCE NO: 369 AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DITROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN: Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, by the owner of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota: Lot 20, City View Beach, according to Plat, owned by Lakes Publishing Company, Inc. A tract of land in the North Half of the Northeast Quarter (No NEX) of Section 10, Township 138 North, Range 41 West of the Fifth ... Principal Meridian, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the point at which the North line of said NE% of Section 10 intersects the Southwesterly right-of-way line of Becker County Highway #114 (as the same was laid out and existing on the 6th day of May, 1977); thence proceeding West on and along the North line of said NE% on an assumed bearing of North 900 00' 00" West to the Northwest corner of the said Northeast Quarter; thence proceeding South 00 5' 44" East a distance of 534 feet; thence proceeding North 900 00' 00" East. 2564.83 feet to the Westerly right-of-way line of said Becker County Highway #114; thence proceeding in a generally Northerly and Westerly direction on and along the more Westerly and Southerly right-of-way line of said Highway #114 to the point of beginning and there terminating, owned by Lakes Publishing Company, Inc. All of Lot Four (4) of City View Beach Subdivision, EXCEPTING THEREFROM the Easterly portion of said Lot 4 described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Southeast corner (iron stake) of said Lot 4; thence running South 740 ll' West 35.0 feet in the Northerly line of a public road, to an iron stake; thence running North 050 55' West 194.3 feet to an iron stake on the shoreline of Detroit Lake; thence running North 680 11' East 25.0 feet along the shoreline of said lake to an intersection (iron stake) with the Easterly line of said Lot 4; thence running Southeasterly in the said Easterly line of Lot 4 to the point of beginning and there terminating. All of Lot Five (5) of City View Beach Subdivision, according to plat. All of Lot Six (6) of City View Beach Subdivision, according to plat, EXCEPTING THEREFROM that part of Lot Six (6) described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Lot Six (6); thence running North 740 11' East fifteen (15.0) feet in the Southerly line of said Lot Six (6) to an iron stake; thence running Northerly parallel to the Westerly line of the said Lot 6 to the water's edge of Detroit Lake; thence running Westerly along the water's edge of Detroit Lake to the West line of the said Lot Six (6); thence running Southerly in the west line of said Lot 6 to the point of beginning, owned by John R. Meyer and Mary H. Meyer. Section 2. The City Council hereby determines that: The annexation will be in the best interests of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.

2. The territory described herein abuts upon the City of Detroit Lakes and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to the city government.

3. The area to be annexed consists of approximately 26.0 acres and has I residence occupied by 2 people.

Section 3. Therefore, the Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same hereby is annexed to and included in the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the County Auditor, the Secretary of State, and the Clerk of the Town Board, and from and after its passage and publication.




