WHEREAS: Minnesotans cherish the musical ties that enrich our lives and bind us to peoples throughout the nation and the world; and

WHEREAS: Leland B. Sateren has served as an outstanding Minnesota ambassador of music, leading Augsburg College music groups on 32 tours throughout the United States, Canada, and Northern Europe; and

WHEREAS: Leland B. Sateren has contributed more than 400 works to the world of choral music, ranging from settings for folk tunes to innovative interpretations of contemporary poets; and

WHEREAS: Leland B. Sateren has been a major contributor to worship and hymnody of the Christian church through service on committees that developed and published two major hymnals; and

WHEREAS: Leland B. Sateren has given unselfishly of his time and talent in conducting scores of choral workshops in the United States, Canada, Norway, and Sweden; and

WHEREAS: Leland B. Sateren will be retiring from the directorship of the Augsburg Choir at the end of this school year after serving for 29 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, in appreciation of his continuing contributions to the choral heritage of Minnesota and the world, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, proclaim Saturday, February 3, 1979, as
