WHEREAS: A viable, well-staffed army is an important component of our national security; and

WHEREAS: The United States Army has existed successfully in a no-draft environment for the past six years; and

WHEREAS: Through their enlistment, highly qualified young people from the State of Minnesota have contributed significantly to the success of the all-volunteer Army; and

WHEREAS: These young Minnesotans have helped to create and maintain the most superior Army in its 204 year history;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February to be

ARMY ENLISTMENT MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to pay tribute to the noble objectives of the United States Army Recruiting Command.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol the twenty-fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-nine and of the State the one hundred twenty-first.
