

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Ski for Light, a non-profit corporation, is an official Sons of Norway outreach; and

WHEREAS: Ski for Light is sponsoring a series of Skiathons for the Vinland National Center, the health sports facility for handicapped people to be built in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: These Skiathons will be held during the week of January 21 through January 27, 1979, in the Twin Cities, Red Wing, Madison, St. Cloud, Detroit Lakes and Bemidji; and

WHEREAS: Skiers from Norway will join recreational skiers from Minnesota to make this a truly international, people-to-people program; and

WHEREAS: These skiers will participate in the Skiathons under sponsorship to help raise money for Vinland National Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 21 through January 27, 1979, to be

in Minnesota, and urge the people of our State to support this and other programs which promote athletic activities for our handicapped and non-handicapped citizens
